## Literacy

We will be using a range of stimuli and texts to create two narratives and an explanation text this term. We will start with writing a narrative using the short film 'The Lost Thing' as our stimulus and then move onto 'The boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse' to write our second narrative. We are then going to be writing a non-fiction piece titled 'How a robot dog works'

## Maths

We will be focusing on a range of topics this term including:  
Multiplication and division.  
Length and perimeter.  
Fractions, decimals and mass and capacity.

## Science

Electricity - We will be making circuits and switches to see how electricity travels.  
Sound - We are going to test how different materials make different sounds through vibrations.

## History

We are going to be discussing two different fires that have had a detrimental effect on our country. The two fires we will be comparing are the Great fire of London and the Grenfell Towers.

## Computing

We will be focussing on how to sequence simple sounds in scratch for the first half term and then After half term we will be editing photographs.
